QUINTA DOS LOIVOS Sul

This wine embodies the singularity of our old vineyards, preserving viticultural biodiversity and honouring the legacy of ancestral grape varieties.

The south-facing exposure shapes its aromatic profile by promoting a more intense and consistent ripening of the grapes. With greater sunlight throughout the day, the vines develop fruit with higher sugar levels and richer phenolic compounds, resulting in wines that are fuller-bodied, more structured, and more expressive, marked by intense and complex aromas of black fruits such as black cherry, alongside floral and spicy nuances.

Aromatically, it reveals a distinct floral component, with violet notes, a hallmark of the abundance of *Touriga Nacional*, intertwined with ripe black fruit, black spice, and a touch of new oak.

On the palate, the fruit shines, the oak tames the tannins, and the spice builds with remarkable intensity. *Quinta dos Loivos Sul* finishes precise, long, and powerful.
